RRB Group D recruitment is open for Level 1 post like helper, track maintenance, gateman, etc. The selection of the candidates for recruitment will be done on the basis of CBT, followed by PET and document verification. The selected candidates will fall under 7th CPC pay matrix and get a pay of Rs. 18000, plus allowances.

Railway Group D 2018 Eligibility Criteria

Only those candidates who fulfill eligibility criteria of RRB CEN 02/2018 will be recruited. It is the candidate's responsibility to check eligibility. Indian Railway will check and ensure the eligibility of a candidate during the document verification round.

Railway Grade D Educational Qualification

For Electrical/ Engineering/ S / T Department / Medical and Traffic Department –

- Should have passed Class 10th, **OR**
- Should have an ITI from institutions recognised by NCVT/SCVT or its equivalent, **OR**
- Should hold a National Apprenticeship Certificate (NAC) granted by NCVT.

Railway Group D Age Limit

The lower age limit for the candidate is **18 years** of age. Whereas, the upper age limit is **33 years** of age.

RRB Group D 2018 Exam Pattern

Earlier, the Board announced that there will be 100 question in the examination. However, now the Board has announced the complete exam pattern of RRB Group D 2018. It is as follows:

- **Number of Questions in the Exam** – There will be 100 questions in the exam. These will be of multiple choice type.
- **Duration of the Exam** – Candidates will get 90 minutes to solve the exam. However, PwD candidates will get 120 minute (2 hours) to solve the exam.

- **Sections in the exam** – The questions in the exam will be asked from Mathematics, General Intelligence and Reasoning, General Science, and General awareness and Current Affairs.
- **Distribution of Question** – From Maths and Science 25 questions will be asked. From General Intelligence and Reasoning 30 questions will be asked, and from Current Affairs 20 questions will be asked.
- **Negative Marking:** There will be a negative marking of 1/3 marks for every incorrect answer.
